## PRIVACY STATEMENT

### KEEPING INFORMATION ABOUT YOU PRIVATE AND SAFE

The Central Land Council (CLC) sometimes collects and uses **‘personal information’** about you so that it can do its jobs under the Land Rights Act.

**‘Personal information’ means** information you tell the CLC about yourself such as:

- your full name
- your mobile number
- your address
- your bank account details

**You have a right** to have any personal information you give to the CLC **kept private and safe.**

**The CLC has strong rules about protecting your personal information.**

- CLC staff are only allowed to use your personal information to do CLC business.
- CLC staff should tell you why they are collecting your personal information and where they will keep that information.

**You can speak up and ask CLC staff questions about your personal information** like:

- Will the CLC keep information I give them forever?
- How do I know that the information that the CLC has about me is right?
- Will the CLC give information about me to other people?

If you think the CLC has done the wrong thing with your personal information you should **make a complaint.**
